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INTRODUCTION TO THE COVID-19 PREVENTION PROTOCOL

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the AUDI FIS Ski World Cup in Madonna di Campiglio (TN – Italia) at 22.12.2020 must be held under increased security measures.

Due to the current national and local regulations, according to FIS prevention measures and Organizing Committee dispositions (LOC) we hereby send the protocol of instructions to be taken by the Teams at Madonna di Campiglio event the next 22.12.2020.

This action is part of a wider project of Prevention and Safety against COVID 19 Risk (available on the event website www.3trecompiglio.it), adopted by the LOC, in partnership with local authorities to protect workers health and the entire community as well.

We kindly ask you to forward this protocol to all team members (athletes, coaches, service people, NSA officials etc.) who are registered via the FIS platform.

By registering for this event, each team member entirely confirms and accepts the contents of this protocol of measurements for the above mentioned event in full and undertakes to respect it for the good and the health of the community.

This protocol is composed by general and specific measures of prevention mentioned below, covering behavioural and organizing requirements, both collective and individual.

According to the following suggestions, it is recommended to each Team to independently ensure that specific containment measures for COVID 19 risk are developed.



GENERAL PREVENTIVE MEASURES

1. Distance and Protection

It is mandatory to maintain in every situation and condition interpersonal safety distance of at least 1 meter (social distancing) and to wear Individual respiratory Protection Equipment (respiratory IPE) in all indoor areas, except for private living quarters, and in all outdoor places, apart from all the specific situations for which is possible to guarantee a continuous condition of isolation.

For those who are carrying out sports activities this obligation may be waived (see below).

Anyway it is strongly recommended to use the Individual respiratory Protection Equipment (respiratory IPE) also inside the private living quarters (e.g. Hotel rooms) in case of presence of not permanently cohabitant people.

It is allowed to use also "community masks": disposable masks or washable ones, even if self made, but produced by multilayer materials, because they can provide a suitable barrier, and, at the same time, able to ensure comfort and breathability, in addition to shape and adhesion, which , must guarantees to cover the area between chin and nose.

Therefore, unless otherwise specified:

It is mandatory to always wear a protection to mouth and nose (face mask) on the entire location of the event, except:

- inside the private living quarters (e.g. Hotel rooms);
- during mealtimes;
- during the practice of sport: pre-race activity on/off the track and race activity 1st and 2nd run;
- exclusively the athletes involved on the warm up zone and the starting area (according to social distancing precaution)

2. Sanification

The use of the Individual respiratory Protection Equipment (respiratory IPE) is reinforced with the other measures of control of the infection as the constant and careful hand hygiene and the disinfection of equipment and materials.



3. Rules of Conduct

From 10 o'clock P.M. To 5 o'clock A.M. The only movements allowed are for demonstrated needs (e.g. Health reasons).

It is strongly recommended, for the rest of the day, to move from your accommodation strictly for purposes relating the event activities, taking care, wherever possible, to avoid gatherings.

So, please, spend your free time only with your team members, in small groups.

Minimise your activities to the necessary purchases and the urgent tasks that you can't absolutely postpone.

4. Avoid gatherings

It is mandatory for all the public places, cabins ski lift and adjacent access spaces included, to expose at the entrance signboards with the requirements about the maximum number of people simultaneously allowed.

Each one of us has to observe this maximum number of people allowed in.

We recommend a good and previous organization to avoid a delay on the fixed time because of a long wait.

To reduce at the minimum the risk of infection, the LOC advise to all the teams the following:

- Remain in small groups;
- Avoid other teams contact;
- Avoid LOC staff contact;
- Avoid tourist and fans contact;
- Journalists interview only at distance and with Individual respiratory Protection Equipment (respiratory IPE);
- Wash and sanitize properly and periodically your hands;
- Have a documentation of your current state of health



SPECIFIC PREVENTIVE MEASURES

1. Racing in Italy and Travel Restriction

Nowadays, in Italy, are allowed only events and competitions organized by National and International Sports Agencies and without an audience (called "closed events").

The athlete workout sessions are granted without audience presence too, according to Federation protocols and observing the requirement about social distancing of at least 2 meters.

In case of athletes, coaches, judges and race stewards or companions arriving from Countries for which entry in Italy is forbidden or for which the quarantine is requested, before entering Italy, they have to perform an antigenic or molecular COVID 19 test to verify their health status not older than 72 hours upon arrival on Italian territory and the result of the test has to be indicated on the declaration provided for the entire list refer to the attachment n. 20 of the DPCM 03.11.2020 see on this link:

For everyone else it will be available in Madonna di Campiglio a sampling point and a health center all times during the event and it will be located in loc. Palù– Tre Ville fraz. Madonna di Campiglio [3Tre C19 Test and Health Center](#) (reference will be communicated as soon as possible).



Journey to Madonna di Campiglio

- In case of COVID-19 symptoms do not travel to the venue.
- Avoid stops between the departure point and the event location.
- Avoid contact with other people - especially outside the team.

EVENT REGISTRATION

Entries will only be accepted from National Ski Associations following FIS quotas and rules for the Alpine Ski World Cups. Entries only will be accepted via the FIS online registration system within the mentioned deadlines. The World Cup rules are available on the FIS website.

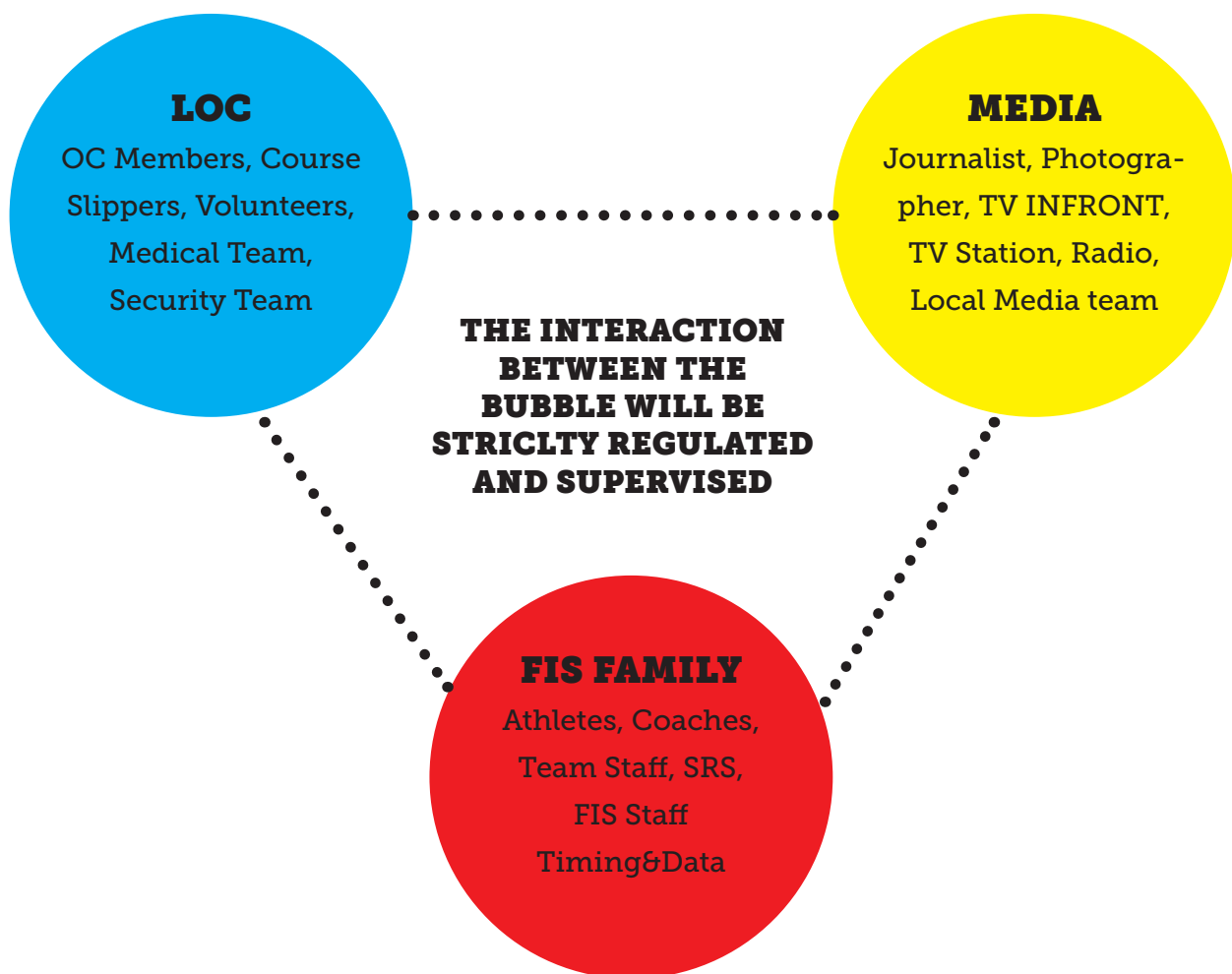

3TRE PREVENTION PLAN CONCEPT

Following the FIS Prevention e Mitigaton Guidelines one the core elements to guarantee a good level of safety shall be creating different "bubbles" ("FIS Snowflakes") whereby groups who are being regularly tested and disciplined to follow rules and regulations shall be limited to interact with persons not being subject to strict protocols.

3TRE Bubbles System





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For each group specific prevention measures are envisaged relating to the various operational activities.

There are also operational locations and differentiated flows that limit the interaction between the different bubbles.

The following information collected in the document will provide the necessary information for the individual groups (RED bubbles) in order to describe all the specific measures and useful information



3TRE TEAM INFORMATION FOR TEST AND TEST PROTOCOL

Team members, officially entered by their respective NSA, via the FIS PASSPORT online system, are obliged to present a negative PCR test not older than 72 hours.

Test results must be uploaded at least 12 hours before arrival on the FIS passport platform.

However, PCR tests submitted to be entered in ALTA BADIA will be retained valid, for those who started in GS or SL, for MADONNA DI CAMPIGLIO too, even if older than 72 hours.

A **C19 Test and Health Center** will be operating in Madonna di Campiglio at all times during the event to monitor eventual symptomatic cases and perform rapid antigenic tests if this should be the case. A positive result will determine exclusion from the race and withdrawal of accreditation.

The **3Tre C19 Test and Health Center** is located in Piazza Brenta, Palù - Madonna di Campiglio, as shown in the map, in the temporary structure as DRIVE-THROUGH health assessment stands (mobile pre-triage COVID - 19 station).

During the procedure for carrying out the swab, athletes and accompanying persons will not have to leave the car, they will be asked to lower the windows and the swab will be performed directly in the car. At the end of the examination, athletes and companions will be invited to wait, still in the car, in the dedicated parking lots, outside the mobile health care station for pre-triage COVID - 19, waiting for the report.

- People who test positive will not be allowed to take part to the event and the specific procedure for C-19 positive case will be follow.

Antigenic Test cost: 30€ (TBC)

COVID-19 Communication

- In case of symptoms immediately inform the LOC at the **3Tre C19 Test and Health Center**



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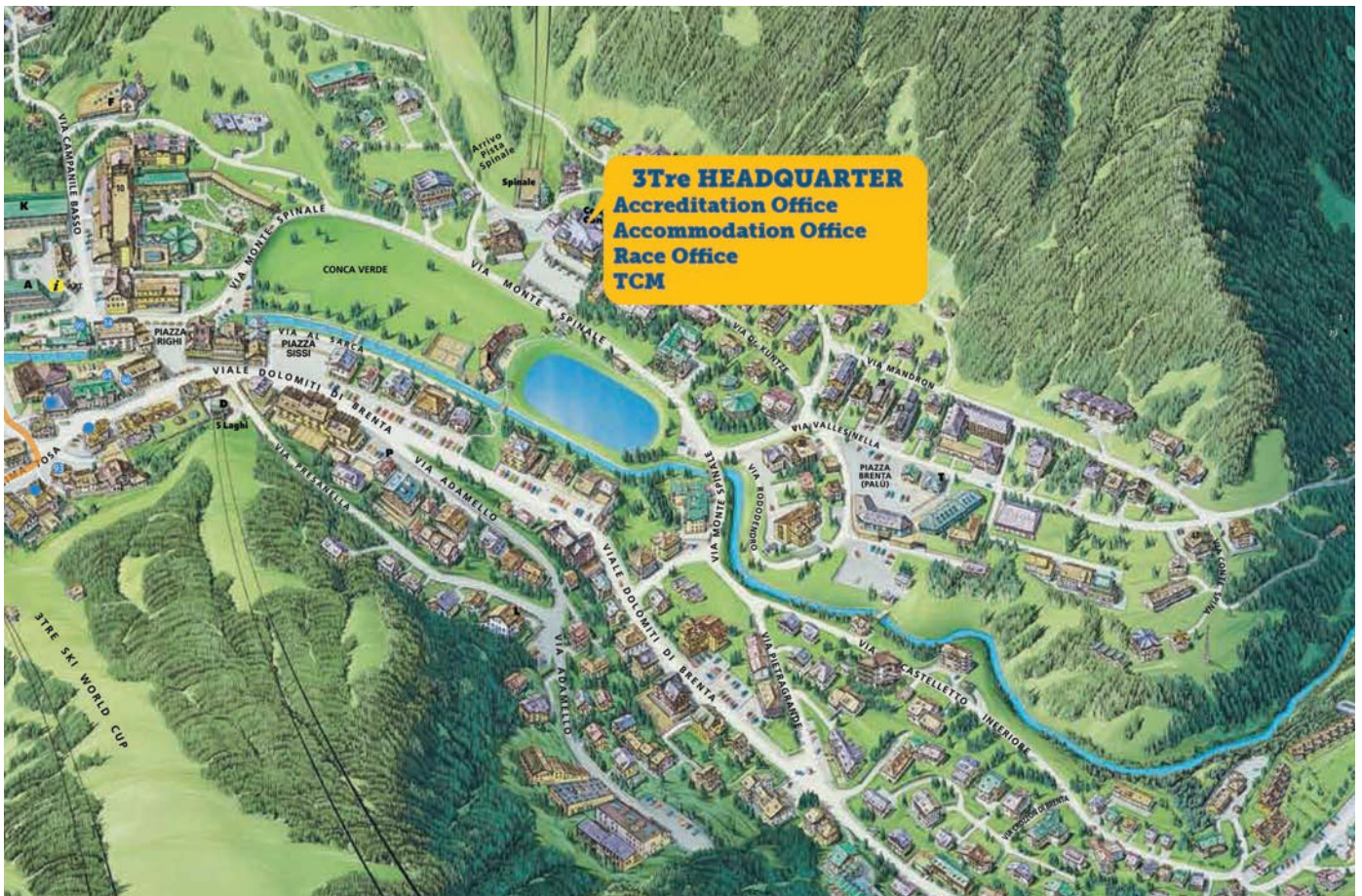
- LOC activates the COVID-19 rescue chain

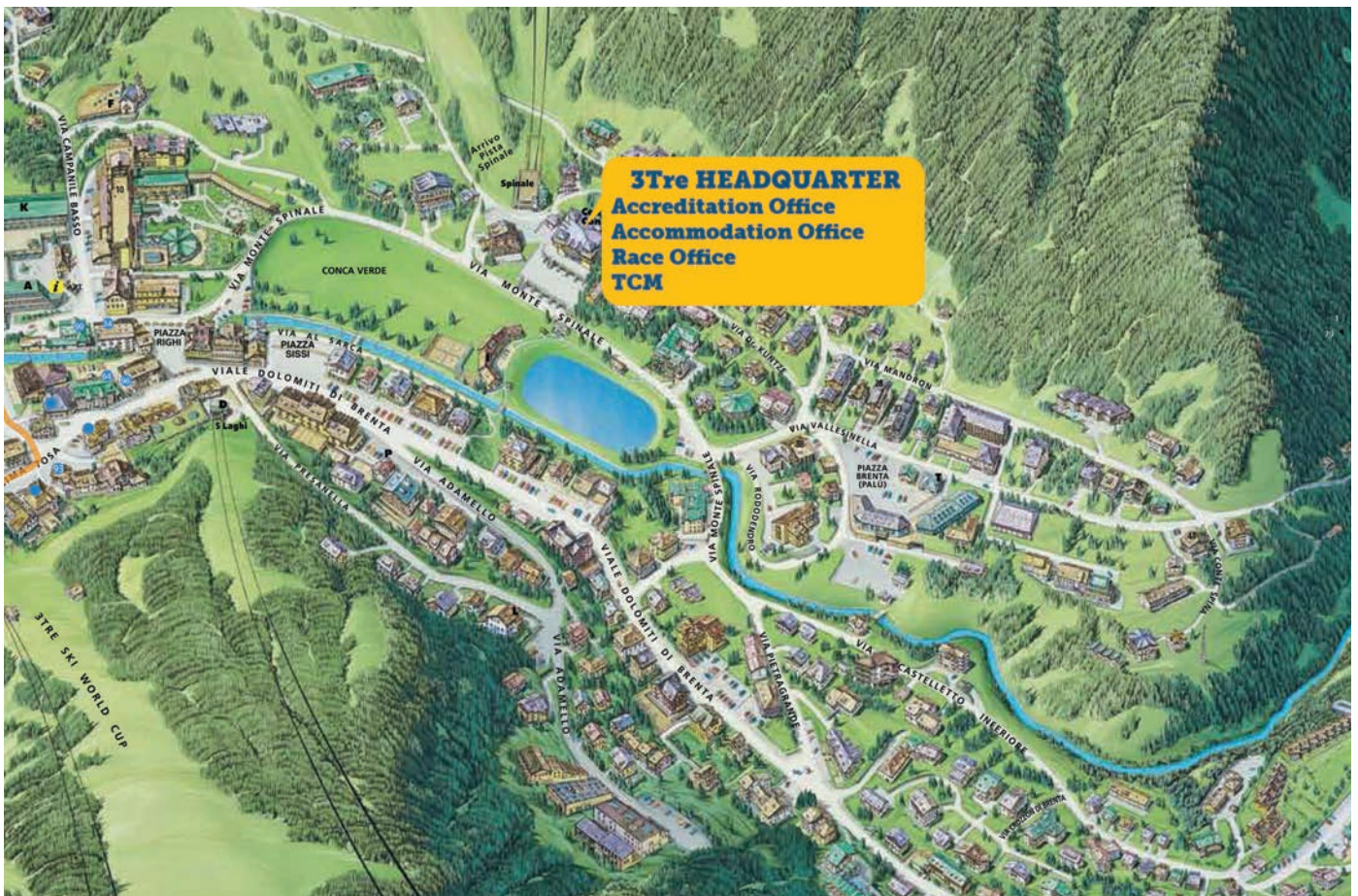

Due the current situation, the LOC must limit the number of accredited persons, we remind all the stakeholder to limit the accreditation request to the necessary number of people who are really involved during the World Cup Races.

In addition to the FIS PASSPORT platform , the accreditation system of the LOC, Event-builder will be the operating platform that will activate all the necessary steps aimed at validating the request and issuing the accreditation (data collection, test verification by the doctor, collection of medical questionnaires)

Only at the end of the Eventbuilder application process the applicant can pick up the accreditation and occupy the reserved rooms of the hotel. For any need, the reference email [**accreditation@3trecampiglio.it**](mailto:accreditation@3trecampiglio.it)

Only the team captain or a team representative can collectively receive accreditations.

Please note that specific protection measurements have been adopted on the event site to protect the employees of the LOC and all the others; requirements that must also be observed by the teams when they approach the staff; these provisions are contained in the COVID 19 risk prevention / protection system adopted by the LOC and available on the website.

According to the FIS World Cup rules we will be offer accommodation from the official arrival day until the official departure day. Teams must announce the room reservation via the FIS online registration system.

Please note that accommodation at the FIS rate is available for the official dates of the program only:

Arrival: Monday, 21st of December

Departure: Wednesday , 23rd December

Early arrivals and late departures are subject to availability and are not available at the FIS rate.

Additional Officials have to be paid directly the CHF 120,- per night in the hotel.

Any extras must be paid by the teams or athletes themselves.

- The LOC has reserved exclusive team accommodation (no audience/tourists).
- The hotels are currently reserved only for athletes and officials according to the FIS quota for the period of the official arrival until the official departure
- Should team members arrive early or leave later, please inform the LOC immediately at the following e-mail address:

- Each team member is obliged to stay in the accommodation allocated by the LOC for the duration of the event.
- Wear a mouth and nose protector in all public areas.
- In the buffet area a mouth and nose protector is compulsory, this can be taken off at the table.
- Further hygiene measures according to the hotels policy.
- Check-in of all team members by the team captain.
- Maintain social distancing in all areas.

The Team Captains Meeting is scheduled at 20:00 on 21 December 2020 at the Sala Tosa del PalaCampiglio.

Access is guaranteed to a limited number of people in the meeting room but it will be possible to follow the meeting in streaming for those who cannot physically access the room:

Access to the TCM will be limited to:

- The jury,
- The Event manager
- The covid referent and match doctor - The match secretary
- Swiss Timing
- 1 representative per Team
- 1 representative of SRS
- 1 representative of the HBC
- 1 representative of INFRONT



HOW TO REACH THE VENUE FROM THE HOTELS

The race office staff will provide each team with the map with updated directions and the car pass to reach Patascoss, the venue where the parking area reserved for the RED group is located near the "Pancugolo" training track and the Team Hospitality "Rifugio Patascoss"

- Prefer transport with the teams' own vehicles.
- If teams do not have their own transport facilities, shuttles can be provided by the LOC.
- Use the routes indicated on the specific map on the site and follow the directions for parking and dedicated plant located in loc. Patascoss
- Avoid stops between the hotel and the venue.
- Use only the team parking and hospitality area assigned and designated for your team.

EVENT AREA: GENERAL MEASUREMENTS

Maintain social distances

- Remain in assigned and marked team zones.
- The team area is delimited and accessible only to accredited persons
- Avoid direct contact with other teams.
- Avoid direct contact with employees / press.
- Mouth and nose protectors must be worn at the venue.

Exceptions:

- While playing sports.
- Meals
- In the start and warm-up area, athletes do not need mouth and nose protection, but mouth and nose protection is mandatory for all coaches / officials present.
- If a team member feels unwell or exhibits COVID-19 symptoms, contact the LOC immediately at the [3Tre C19 Test and Health Center](#)
- In case of symptoms, an isolation room is reserved closer to the place of the event.



EVENT AREA: SPECIFIC MEASUREMENTS

TRAINING

Official training is scheduled on Tuesday 22nd December morning at the 5Laghi ski area, "Pancugolo" slope. The "Patascoss chairlift" and the "Pancugolo" training slope will be used exclusively for the event on 22.12.2020 (no tourists) All people present are registered.

Before each training and competition, a training and competition protocol (see appendix 2) must be handed in to the LOC by each team, in which the health status of the individual team members is documented.

Only the number of people indicated by the appropriate sign can get on the chairlift. Wear mouth and nose protection during ascent.

TEAM HOSPITALITY

Team Hospitality will be hosted at Rifugio Patascoss that will be reserved by the organization for the event.

The entrance is limited only to the team, no service for OC employees or other groups.

- Wearing mask at the entrance and exit and when leaving the table, ventilation and disinfection each time by the staff
- Sit together exclusively with team colleagues (no contact with other teams).
- Tables will be reserved and may be used only by same team members
- Food will be plated by the staff, no self service

ACCESS TO CHAIRLIFT AND COURSE

Access to the chairlift allowed only to authorized and accredited persons, a preferential access corridor is set up for athletes and team officials.

Access to the track is allowed to a limited number of persons authorized by FIS.

FIS will distribute the course access arm bands to the teams at the TCM in a sealed envelope based on the quota provided for by the regulation.

Arm bands will be checked before the chairlift access.

STARTING AREA

The entire starting area is an official athlete / team area (red area), fenced off and not accessible for staff and guests.

The LOC staff and the television staff are not authorized to access the warm-up area and are not allowed to circulate in the starting tent during the race. Only the HBC can operate in the starting tent and in the warm-up area.

Access control is provided.

Starting house + Tunnel:

Access allowed to only 1 athlete + 2 officials per team. Mask mandatory for officials. Check at the entrance to the departure tunnel.

The staff inside the tent must be limited to:

- Judge of Departure
- Swiss timing starter
- Hand timing (preferably between the house and the facade, not directly inside)
- Access controller

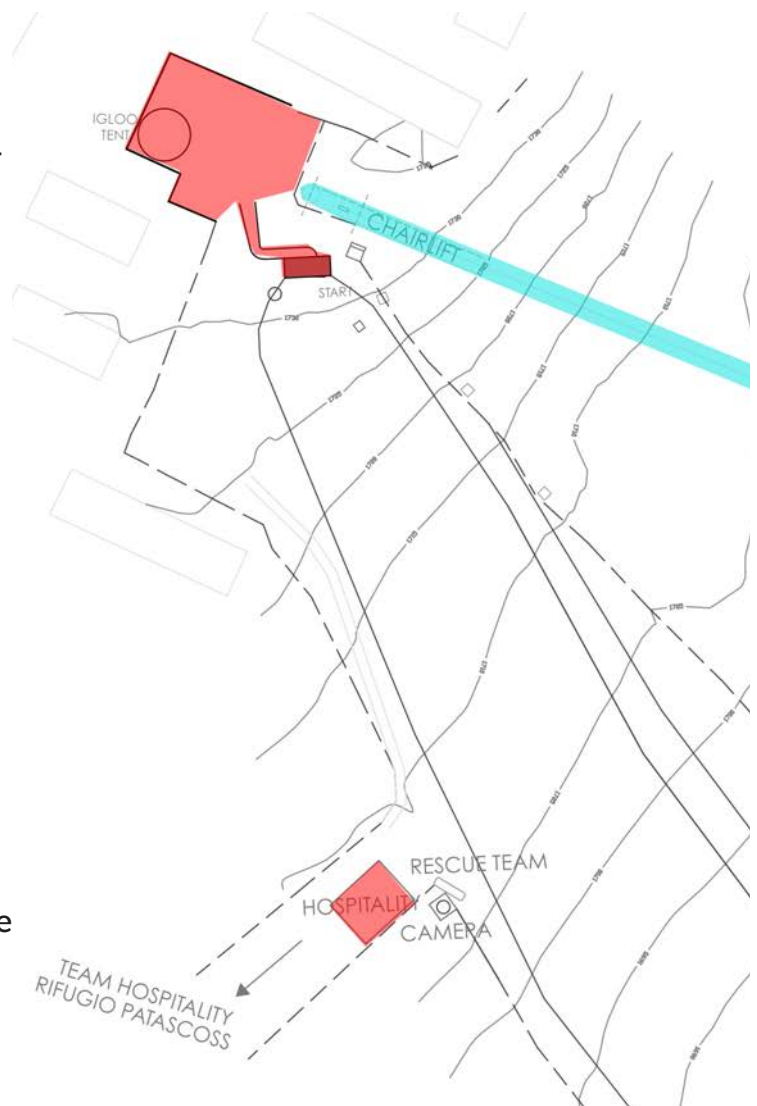
Staff are required to wear a mask

Bibs distribution:

Bibs are distributed by a single person from the LOC outside any enclosed space

Team Tent

Open tent, mask mandatory for everyone



FINISH AREA

Mixed area extension: the total area will be extended according to the current distance measurements protocols.

Circulatory flow in the mixed zone

the circulatory flow is respectful of the separation of groups of relatives, staff and media.

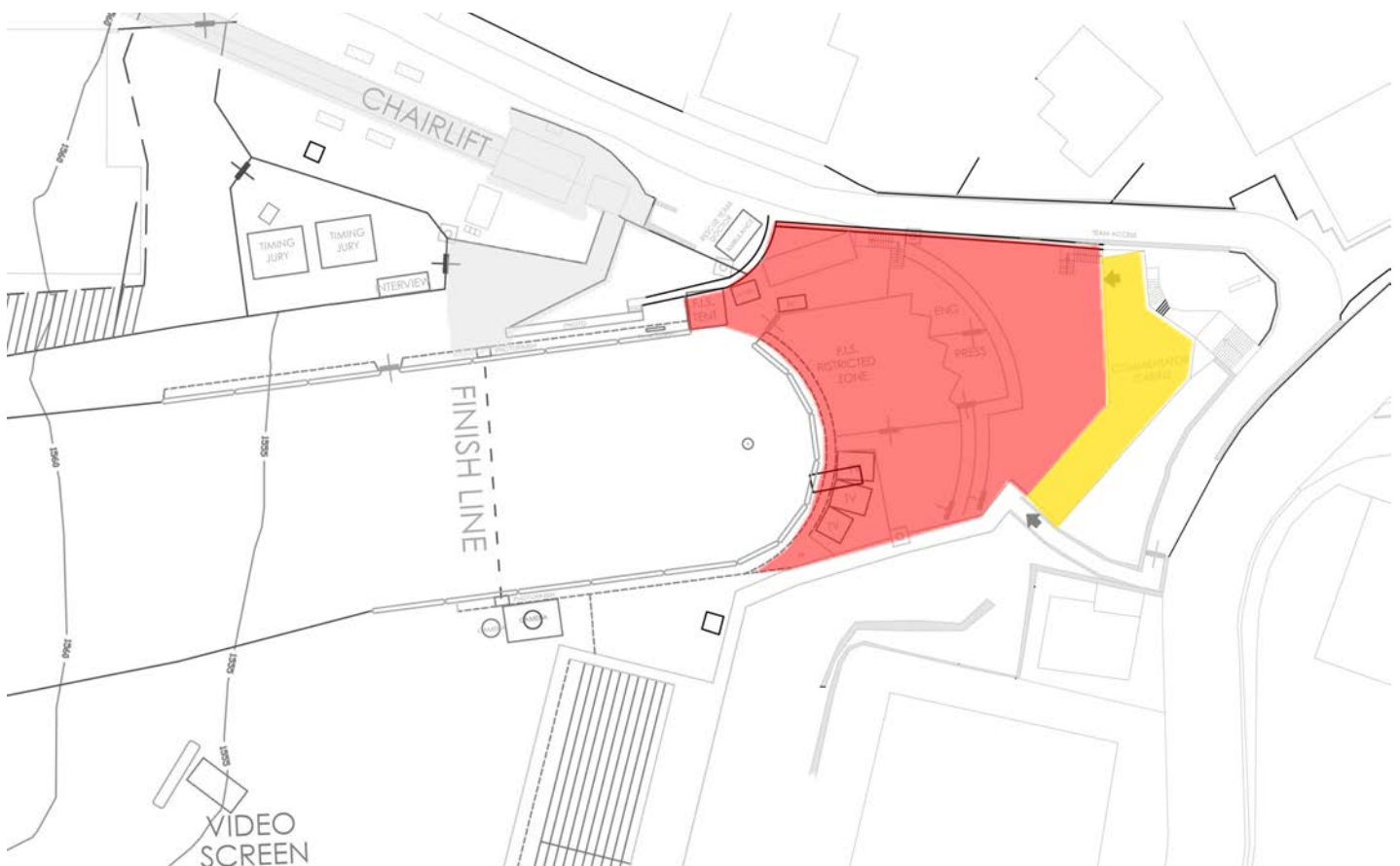
- TV/radio/press must maintain social distance from athletes.
- TV/radio/press must wear masks during interviews.
- The number of media representatives will be severely restricted in agreement with FIS.

Signs

Appropriate signs will be prepared for the better organization of the circulation concept.

LEAVING MADONNA DI CAMPIGLIO

If, in exceptional cases, someone should have to leave Mdc after arrival and before departure, this must be notified immediately in writing to the administration office at: segreteria@3trecampiglio.it

We appeal to EVERYONE to take their OWN RESPONSIBILITY and to comply and implement all measurements and recommendations made!

Guidelines are used to implement or control compliance with the COVID-19 specifications. For your own safety and the safety of other people, you must follow the instructions of the operational staff.

We reserve the right to exclude you from the event and to take legal action in the event of non-compliance with the COVID-19 regulations.

The measurements defined were determined in accordance with the current regulations from 16.11.2020.
