ACCOMMODATION

The FIS Ski Jumping Continental Cup Zakopane 2022 Organizing Committee takes care of full board accommodation for all entered athletes and officials.

Bookings for national teams are organized by the OC according to the team quotas and received entries.

The official COC hotel is COS OPO Zakopane, Br. Czecha 1B, Zakopane.

The price for daily full board accommodation, for those over national quotas, is 80 Euro per person FB.

Additional single rooms are subject to availability. They will not be available until confirmed by the LOC. Single supplement for additional and in-quota single rooms 30 Euro pp.

Cash and credit cards are accepted.

The LOC does not guarantee the availability of accommodation for requests and entries sent later than 25th February.

If available, alternative accommodation shall be provided.

Deadline for free of charge cancellation of rooms is 14 days prior to planned arrival. For rooms booked and not used full price for the whole duration will be charged.
