TEAM INFORMATION FIS SKI JUMPING WORLDCUP ENGELBERG 2022

1. Accommodation

Accommodation bookings are handled by the World Cup Head Office Engelberg according to regulation. Only reservations which have been received by the deadline for pre-registration will be considered. The individual National Ski Associations are guaranteed accommodations only for the numbers of persons who were entered prior to the deadline.

Cancellations:

- Until 14 days before TCM: Cancellation is free of charge for 25% of the rooms booked
- Between 13 - 8 day before TCM: Cancellation is free of charge for 10% of the rooms booked
- 7 days until the departure date: 100% charge of the cancelled rooms

In all cases, no charge will be made if the hotel can resell the rooms.

2. Accreditation

- Requests for additional accreditation must be sent via the FIS Online System or to the Secretariat at weltcup@engelberg.ch.
- All accreditation cards can be picked up at the Accreditation Office on the competition site.

3. Transport

- The World Cup Head Office will provide transportation from and to the airport of Zurich upon request.
- Please register via the FIS Online Entry System incl. exact arrival times, flight numbers, number of arriving people and luggage information.
- Shuttle service: No shuttle service between hotels and venues (walking distance).

4. Gym / Fitness Center

From December 15th to 18th 2022 teams will have full use of the local sports facility. It is free of charge and must be reserved in advance via weltcup@engelberg.ch. First come, first served - preference will be given according to when the registrations have been received. Keys to the facility must be collected at and returned to the Race Office.



Athletes can use the fitness centre at Sporting Park for the following prices: CHF 5.00 per athlete or CHF 80.00 per hour / room. Reservation in advance via weltcup@engelberg.ch.

5. Race Office

The race office is located on the ski jumping area in the basement of the Sporting Park building.

6. Reimbursement

Expenses and travel costs will be reimbursed by banc transfer. Please send it via e-mail to weltcup@engelberg.ch. If you have any questions, we are happy to help at the Race Office. Please note the specific opening hours for financial matters.

7. Prize money

The prize money will be transferred by bank transfer in accordance with the regulations (Word Cup Rules Art. 5.1). Please ensure that all athlete details are online and correct.

8. Waxing facilities

- Booking of waxing cabins via FIS Online Entry System by the preliminary entry. Preliminary entry counts as wax cabin booking. Extra wax cabin must be ordered.
- The keys to the cabins are available at the race office. Keys return at the service area on the day of departure.
- Parking cards can be picked up at the race office together with the keys.

9. Catering

- The catering for athletes, trainers and staff will be provided at least 1 hour before the official training / competition times at the athlete's tent at the jumping hill area.
- On Thursday, 15th the dinner will be served at the hotel, please enter in the official Entries the expected arrival time.
- On Friday, 16th and Saturday, 17th lunch and dinner will be served at the hotel.
- Due to the competition program on Sunday, 18th, there will be a reduced catering for lunch at the athlete's tent.

11. Testing protocol by LOC or host country

12. Regulations of radio equipment/Radio Frequencies

Application for a temporary radio licence

The Organizing Committee was informed that the Federal Office of Communications (OFCOM) will conduct an official on-site frequency usage check on the occasion of the ski jumping event in Engelberg 2022. We ask you to check whether your equipment (radio transmission equipment of any kind) is subject to registration or concession in accordance with Swiss law.
