2. Rules

- Georgian Ski Federation, Mountain Resorts Development Company and the organizing committee of the FIS Snowboard Cross Junior World Championship are organizing Junior World Championships in Gudauri ski resort.
- The competition will be held under FIS rules and regulations of FIS Snowboard / Freestyle / Freeski international competition Rules.
- This competition is a Snowboard Cross event and is open to both Men, Women.
- The years of birth are 2004-2008.
- This competition will follow an official program that will be available to all participants.
- The organizing committee reserves the right to change the schedule depending on the snow conditions, weather or decision of the competition jury.

3. Entries

Registration/Entries

Entries will be accepted in accordance with the FIS quotas and rules.

All entries must be done using the FIS Online Registration System, through the FIS home page: <http://www.fis-ski.com/> "Member Section". FIS has established Nation Quotas for World Cups. National Ski Teams can only enter World Cup Competitors according to the Quota limitations. Maximum 6 athletes per gender and per nation.

Deadlines for Team Entries:

Preliminary Entries (women/men): 10.03.2023

Final Entries: 24.03.2024

4. Registration and means of Payment

- All teams are responsible to arrive and register at race office – located in Hotel “TBA” on the first Team Captain’s meeting, April 4th.
- Accommodation with Half Board for the dates: 3 April - 7 April 2024, is CHF 100 per person per night.
If a nation doesn’t take this offer there will be a participation fee of max. 40, - CHF per event day per athlete including Lift Ticket.

Important information: To accommodate all athletes, coaches and officials in a correct way, we do need your updated Preliminary Team Entries as soon as possible, March 17th, 2024, the latest.

5. Bibs

All competitors must wear their bibs during the official training, competition, and awards ceremony after the competition.

6. Transfer

- Participants are responsible for their own transportation. Gudauri ski resort is located 144 km away from Tbilisi international airport, The OC offers transfers between the airport of Tbilisi and the resort (busses, mini vans for teams and trucks for equipment). Transfer requests are to be sent to office trifectasportstours@gmail.com (TBC) and should include the following information:
 1. Arrival/departure date, time, flight numbers, destination (from/to)
 2. Number of passengers and all names of participants in a group
 3. Amount of luggage in pieces and its approximate total weight.
- Transportation on site will be provided by The OC and will be free of charge.
- Competitors, coaches and OC key staff will be accommodated in Hotel "TBA"
- The Team Captains meeting will be held in Hotel "TBA" conference room. For detailed information please see the attached competition Program.



7. Liability

- All participants are urged not to be negligent in safeguarding their personal belongings at all time.

8. Accident Insurance

- Every Competitor must be individually medically insured. The Organizing Committee: Georgian ski Federation, Mountain Resorts Development Company and the FIS will not be held responsible for accidents or damaged equipment during the training and competition.

9. Accident Protocol

- In case of an accident on the course during the event, medical staff from the Organizing Committee and Ski Patrol will be responsible for any medical decision or evacuation to the Tbilisi Medical Centre or local hospital.

10. Anti-Doping & Fluor-Ban Control

- Anti-doping and/or Fluor-Ban control may be conducted for each gender.
